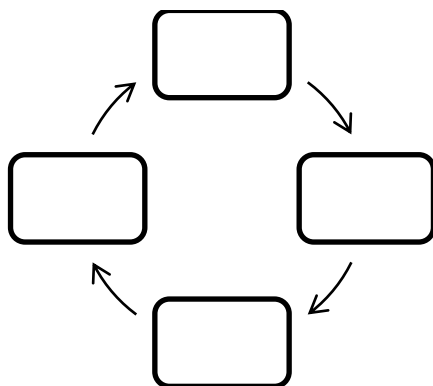

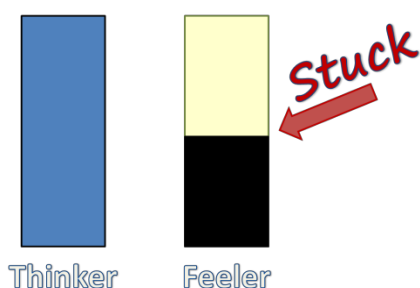

TWO CONCEPTS: CAPACITY AND WARFARE



CAPACITY: MATURITY IS MEASURED BY EMOTIONAL CAPACITY.

- **OUTLET PRINCIPLE**— WHEN OUR CAPACITY IS EXCEEDED, WE TEND TO EITHER SHUT DOWN OR BLOW UP
- **THINKER/FEELER (BILL GILHMAM)**



- **CAPACITY IS STUNTED BY TRAUMA**

A TRAUMA STUNTS CAPACITY THROUGH THE ABSENCE OF THE GOOD WE NEED.

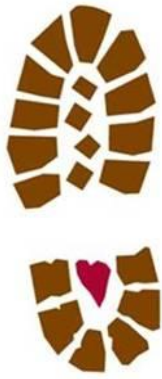


B TRAUMA STUNTS CAPACITY THROUGH THE BAD THAT HAPPENS TO US

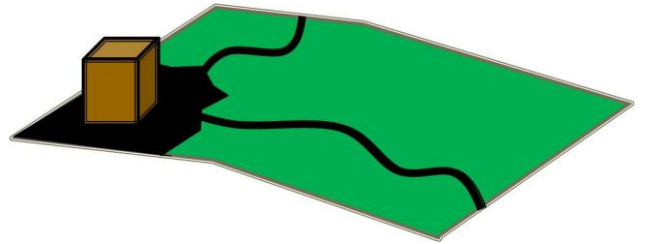

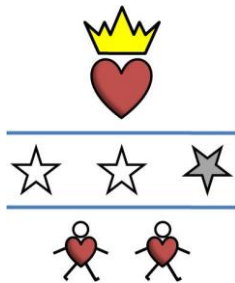

THREE CHALLENGES: BONDAGE, BAGGAGE, BONDING



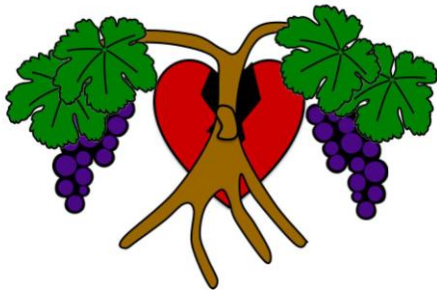
BONDAGE

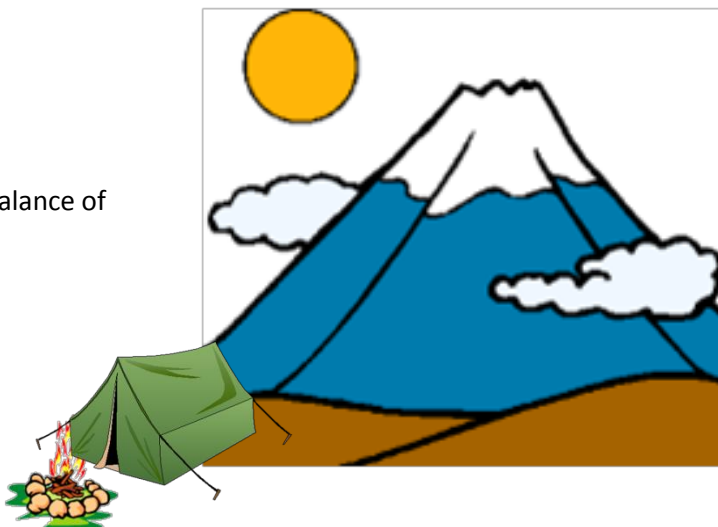

BONDING

- A. Maturity is my job; not God's
- B. Building Maturity Skills requires a balance of Hard Work and Rest



- C. Building Maturity means developing Wisdom
 - a. **Discernment**: The ability to distinguish good from evil; what is satisfying from what is merely pleasurable.
 - b. **Discipline**: The strength to choose good over evil; that which is satisfying over what is simply pleasurable.
- D. Building Maturity requires developing relational skills
 - a. Joy Bonds vs. Fear Bonds
 - b. Remaining relational under stress
 - c. Building Belonging
 - d. Mentoring
